What is C.A.P.P.?

The Career Advanced Placement Program (CAPP) is designed for college-bound students who would like to get a **head start in college**. Through this program, high school students are able to take classes at Santiago Canyon College, which may be used towards their Bachelors or Associate Degree.



Benefits of CAPP

Students will have the opportunity to take a college class while still in high school.

College level classes that provide the same rigor of classes held on college campus.

These classes, which normally cost \$46 a unit, are *FREE for high school students. (\$19 health/ student fee required)

Students are able to earn college units towards a bachelors or associates degree.

Most 100+ level classes can be used towards a degree at CC, CSU,UC and even some private Universities.

Important Information (cont...)

- 1. This is a real 16 week college course.**
- 2. Classes include CAPP students and possibly other continuing college students at SCC.**
- 3. All classes are offered for dual credit (please check with your counselor to ensure you will obtain dual credit).**
- 4. CAPP students cannot take more than 11 units/semester.**
- 5. You are establishing a permanent college transcript**
- 6. Drop Deadlines for full-semester 16 week courses:**
 - Last day to pay \$19 before drop: 1/19/2016
 - Last day to drop for a full refund: 2/21/16
 - Last day to drop with a “W” grade: 5/8/16

Important Information (cont...)

Family Education & Rights Privacy Act (FERPA)

Once a student is enrolled at any college, the information pertaining to the student is theirs and theirs alone.

We do not have the right to share the students information with anyone other than the student. This includes their personal information, class information, transcripts, etc...

Students must come in person and request their information be given out, if that is what they wish to do.

Parents must be “hands off” after registration.

Steps to fill out online application:

1. Log on to www.sccollege.edu.
2. Select “ Apply”button on top left.

- There are TWO parts to the application. You are only done once you receive a confirmation number.
