Parking Permit Rules and Regulations

- Students **MUST PRESENT** a valid CA Driver's License when submitting an application. **NO DRIVER'S PERMITS ACCEPTED.** Students may apply for a Parking Permit once they receive a Driver's License, if space is available.
- Senior students will be given first priority. Juniors will receive permits through a lottery process after school begins, if space is available. Freshman and sophomores are not allowed to purchase parking permits due to space availability.
- Student Parking Permits are valid **ONLY** in the CHS Student Parking Lot. Any student parking in a staff or visitor parking space will have their permit revoked and subject to ticketing from the Anaheim Police Department.
- Parking Permits **MUST** hang from the **VEHICLE OF RECORD'S REAR VIEW MIRROR** , and may not be removed.
- Only one Parking Permit will be issued for the vehicle on the application; permits may **NOT** be used by any student other than the name on the original application.
- Students are responsible to update their vehicle information in the Student Center when it changes. If a student changes their primary vehicle, students must report to the Student Center to update their parking application information.
- Permits **MUST NOT** be tampered with. If a student sells, makes a fake copy, or gives their permit to another student, they will lose the permit for the rest of the school year **without a refund.**
- Students must drive safely and follow proper entry and exit procedures set forth by Canyon High School and the Campus Supervisors. Do not block aisles, gates, or fire lanes. Park only within marked parking spaces. Any student misusing their parking permit, or not following the parking lot rules, is subject to having his/her permit **revoked without a refund.**
- Parking permit eligibility will be reviewed at the end of each quarter. Any student with more than two detentions is subject to having their permit revoked and not returned until detentions are cleared. **Refunds will not be issued.**
- Cars without a valid Parking Permit will be ticketed or towed by the Anaheim Police Department.
- Detection dogs are authorized to search Canyon High School. Vehicles that are sensed will be searched with a student present.
- CHS hereby declares itself **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for and assumes no liability arising from fire, theft, damage to, or loss of the vehicle or any article left therein.
- A \$50 replacement fee will be imposed if a student loses their parking permit.

By signing and dating this agreement, both parties *UNDERSTAND AND AGREE to the above Rules and Regulations*. Both parties also understand that purchasing a parking permit does **NOT guarantee a parking spot. Application must be **COMPLETE**.**

Parking Permit Info:

- A valid driver's license must be presented with the application to purchase a permit.
- Applications are turned in with payment to the ASB office.
 - Payments can be made with cash, check, or credit card.
- After the senior only deadline of August 19th, permits will be issued to seniors and juniors as a lottery.

Important Dates- Seniors Only:

Monday 8/8 - Parking permit applications available for seniors only at TCOB and the CHS website.

Wednesday 8/17- First day to turn in completed applications and payments for seniors only. Permits will be issued upon receipt of payment and completed application.

Friday 8/19- Final day for seniors only to turn in applications and payment.

Important Dates - Juniors and Seniors:

Monday 8/22 - First day to turn in applications (no payment) for senior and junior lottery.

Tuesday 8/23 - LUNCH - Final day to turn in applications (no payment) for senior and junior lottery.

Tuesday 8/23 - AFTER SCHOOL - Email sent to students who received a permit via lottery.

Friday 8/26- Final day for lottery recipients to pay for permits in the ASB office. Permits will be issued upon receipt of payment.

Monday 8/29- All cars in the student parking lot must have permits displayed.
