## Sample Four-Year Plan

The table below represents a sample four-year academic plan for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (DP) as well as IB Certificate opportunities. DP candidates must take at least 6 IB classes in their junior and senior years. All IB courses meet the UC/Cal State A-G requirements and receive a weighted grade. Upon successful completion of the DP program students will receive a stole and IB medallion to wear at graduation and an international diploma. Students should work closely with their counselor and IB coordinators to accommodate extracurricular activities and course selection.
