Sample Four-Year Plan

The table below represents a sample four-year plan for the aviation classes required to complete the Canyon High School Aviation Academy or Aviation Pathway. Academy graduates must complete 4 years of aviation coursework to earn a stole to wear at graduation. Aviation Pathway completers must complete an 02 & 03 course to earn a tassel to wear at graduation. Students should work closely with their counselors to incorporate appropriate honors, IB and AP courses as well as other graduation and A-G required courses.

Aviation Academy Course Descriptions:

Career Focused Aviation (01): Students learn about careers and content related to all aspects of Aviation and Aerospace and work through various hands-on activities.

Aviation I UC-G (02): Content focuses on pilot careers using flight simulators, field trips, guest speakers and more. The class is also relevant to Aerospace Engineering, Military and Air Traffic Control.

Aviation II UC-G (03): Students complete Private Pilot ground school and flight simulator training while still relating to other aspects of Aviation.

Professional Internship (03): Allows students to apply academic knowledge and practice technical and employability skills in a workplace setting. Students will prepare job readiness documents and interview at an assigned site before interning with a local Canyon Business Partner (Flight School, Aerospace Engineering, Aircraft Mechanics, Aviation Business, etc.).
