Sample Four-Year Plan

This represents a sample four-year plan sequencing the required classes to be a Dance Pathway completer. Two years of dance fulfills the Physical Education graduation requirement. Art credit is available for Art of Dance Composition. Students must complete 3 years of dance to be a pathway completer and earn a tassel to wear at graduation. Students should work closely with their counselors to incorporate appropriate honors, IB and AP courses as well as other graduation and A-G required courses.

Dance Pathway Course Descriptions:

Professional Dance I (01): This class introduces the styles and technique of Jazz, Hip Hop, Modern and Ballet. Students will develop body/space awareness as it relates to stage/choreography design. They will understand music with relation to time, space, and energy, while developing choreography skills.

Professional Dance II (02): Students continue to perfect their dance techniques in a variety of disciplines while building choreographic and production skills.

Professional Dance III—The Jr. Company (03) (Audition Only): Jr. Company is a year course that prepares students for "The Company". Dancers will train in Jazz, Ballet and Modern techniques, while continuing to develop choreographic skills. Dancers will also have the opportunity to audition to perform in dance program productions.

Art of Dance Composition—The Company UC-F (03) (Audition Only): "The Company" is a dance ensemble committed to excellence through strong work ethic and character. Performances are required of all dancers and exemplary attendance is required. Events include: Concerts, Festivals, pep rallies and other school-related events and fundraisers. The Dance Company is a one year commitment.
