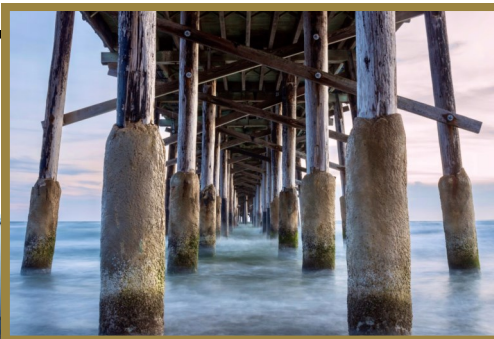

Sample Four-Year Plan

This represents a sample four-year plan sequencing the required classes to be a Photography Pathway completer. Students must complete a level 02 & 03 class to be a pathway completer and earn a tassel to wear at graduation. Students should work closely with their counselors to incorporate appropriate honors, IB and AP courses as well as other graduation and A-G required courses.

Photography Pathway Course Descrip-

Career Focused Arts, Media and Entertainment (01): This course explores careers in the Arts, Media and Entertainment industries. This includes an in-depth focus and hands-on practical experience in the areas of Graphics & Design, Digital Photography, Animation, Video/Media, Performing Arts, and Production.

Art of Digital Photography I UC-F (02): This is a hands-on introduction to Digital Photography. Students explore basic elements of composition and principles of design including light, movement and color theory. Combining training in camera operation and image editing with artistic theory, students learn to creatively communicate their ideas through the art of photography.

Art of Digital Photography II UC-G (03): Students use advanced software and photo skills for graphic and image manipulation to create commercial graphic products and aesthetic fine-art images. The goal of this course is to develop advanced digital artists and photographers by teaching a variety of skills and outcomes.

Professional Internship (03): Allows students to apply academic knowledge and practice technical and employability skills in a workplace setting. Students will prepare job readiness documents and interview at an assigned site prior to interning with a local Canyon Business Partner.
