

CANYON HIGH SCHOOL ONLINE HEALTH CLASS INFORMATION



This information is for those students new to Online Health. The two most important points to take away are that –

- the teacher will notify you when it's your quarter to begin the Online Health class
- and that there is a **mandatory meeting** prior to taking the class

A Class List is handed out at Taking Care of Business (TCOB). This is merely a list of classes that your student will be attending. It is not a schedule. Schedules will be handed out the first day of school in front of the Gym during Zero Period, however, there will not be a Zero Period on the first day of school. Please note that all schedules are subject to change.

Students who have Online Health the First Quarter (August, September, October)	If you have Online Health beginning at the start of the First Quarter, please plan on attending a mandatory meeting . The meeting will be held after school at 2:45 p.m. during the first week of school on that Thursday or Friday. The teacher will notify parents and students of the mandatory meeting on the first day of school. They will send an email to the parents and deliver a notice to the student.
Students who have Online Health AFTER the First Quarter.	The teacher will notify parents and students of the mandatory meeting prior to the start of the quarter. They will send an email to the parents and deliver a notice to the student.
Mandatory Meeting	The meeting is mandatory because the teacher will provide the class requirements and information how to access the online program. This is a meeting for students to attend.
Odd/Even Day Schedule	The Odd / Even Day schedule can be found in the agenda book or online on the Canyon High School home page under Resources.

Tips to Understanding your Class Schedule

In the first column, under "Per"

Per	Per stands for Period
Per 9	Per 9 stands for Online
0 Per	0 Period is a class you attend every day.
Per 1, 3, 5	Classes you attend on Odd Days.
Per 2, 4, 6	Classes you attend on Even Days

In the second column, under "SM"

SM	SM stands for Semester
Y	Y stands for year long.
F	F stands for Fall Semester
S	S stands for Spring Semester
1, 2, 3, 4	Stands for Quarter. Online Health is a Quarter long class. One quarter is equal to 1/2 of a semester.
