

## AP SPANISH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE SUMMER ASSIGNMENT 2021

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***¡Bienvenidos!*** Congratulations on enrolling in the most rigorous Spanish course at Canyon High School. This summer assignment is designed to help you develop the skills necessary to move you from intermediate level to eventually advanced. Read the task descriptions carefully and complete everything to the best of your ability. Please email me if you have any questions. I will be checking my email often during the summer but not daily. Before you begin, please join our Google Classroom using the following code: **o73lenr**

**\*\*\*Late work will not be accepted for this assignment. Having a 0 in one or all of the three tasks will adversely impact your grade for the first semester and you may have to drop the course by Friday, September 3rd.**

### TASK #1: ORAL PRESENTATION

- See the assignment block titled TAREA #1: PRESENTATE A LA CLASE
- This task is 10 points in the Presentational Speaking category (20% of your grade)
- You will need to log into Flipgrid using your @orangeusd email address

### TASK #2: LISTENING LOG

- See the assignment block titled TAREA #2: BITÁCORA DE ESCUCHAR
- This task is 46 points in the Interpretive Communication category (20% of your grade)
- You will spend 18 hours this summer listening to authentic Spanish. The definition of authentic Spanish is a source made by Spanish speakers for Spanish speakers. You are expected to listen to a total of 2 hours per week and complete the listening log for each listening session.
- It is recommended to do 30 minutes sessions at least four times per week. Ideally, you will do this every 1-2 days. Please do not log any extra sessions as it could make your listening log quite long.
- One listening experience (for example: watching a movie) will only count as 30 minutes even if the audio/video source is 2 hours.
- It will take time for you to adjust to authentic Spanish. You will not be able to understand everything. Do not worry; in time, you will become much better at it. The objective is to understand enough so that you will mostly know what is happening.
- If you try to complete the whole listening log the day before it is due, you will end up with a headache and very little development in your language skills. When I look at revision history within your Google document I want to see that the document was constantly updated over the span of 9 weeks.

### TASK #3: LECTURA

- See the assignment block titled TAREA #3: LECTURA. (Please follow the link to Flango there)
- This task is 55 points in the Classwork Category
- We will be reading *La novia perfecta* on Flango.com
- For your first login, please write down your unique code and password. I will not have access to this information and will not be able to check on it for you.
- You will be able to read the story on a tablet, phone, or laptop.

- I will be able to see your progress with the reading. Once you open another tab or leave the page, it will stop tracking your progress. Your time/progress is tracked as you scroll through the reading. Only listening to the audio is not acceptable. You can read only OR listen/read.
- If you choose to leave a review on the book, please know that I will be able to see what you wrote.
- Pacing and deadlines: You should read 1 chapter per week and answer questions to the corresponding chapter that same week. There will be no penalty for reading the book at the same time or turning in chapters after they are due.
- On Google Classroom you will complete 11 sets of questions (1 for each chapter). You will receive 5 points for the chapter questions only if all questions are answered in complete sentences.
- Please note that the last few chapters are all due the night before school starts. All chapters are due on August 17, 2021 before 11:59 p.m.

### **EXTRA SUPPORT**

- This is not for a grade but as an AP Spanish student you should be familiar with the grammar concepts listed below on Conjuguemos
- If you did not have me for Spanish 3 you will need to email me so I can manually add you to my Conjuguemos roster.
- Please note that Canyon High School's Conjuguemos account will expire on August 11th and you may not have access to this platform for a few weeks.
- I highly encourage you to practice because we will not be going over grammar in AP Spanish next year.
- Practice the following verbs/grammar practice on Conjuguemos:
  - Present tense
  - Preterite tense
  - Imperfect tense
  - Future tense
  - Conditional tense
  - Subjunctive: Present tense
  - Ser vs. estar
